The PAMANA Program is anchored on three (3) complementary strategic pillars that define core interventions to achieve just and lasting peace: a) Pillar 1 - policy reform and governance interventions addressing issues on injustices relative to land security, natural resources, identity and human rights; b) Pillar 2 - capacity building interventions relative to strengthening government institutions and empowering communities; 3) Pillar 3 - peace promoting socio-economic interventions.
